- The Gwynfryn playground renovation will start shortly, we are just waiting for the actual date from the contractor
- Our Borough Councillor, Jerry Wellens, has spoken to Wrexham Council about the failed fencing on Minera Hall Road with and it is hoped it will be repaired soon.
- Our local PCSO's are keeping an eye on the issue of the vandalism in Minera playground
- The old derelict phone kiosk in New Brighton has been replaced by a newly renovated one

- We had clarification that cycling is permitted on public footpaths, with the consent of the landowner. Wrexham Council permits this along the footpath from the lead mines up to the kissing gate before Rock Cottage, near the entrance to the quarry.
- A visit has been made to Minera Hall to meet a couple who are seeking to develop the grounds as a nature garden for the community.
 Developments would be monitored from time to time, and any concerns addressed promptly
